

## 2024 NOTICE OF EXCLUSION FROM MEDICARE BENEFITS

There are items and services for which Medicare will not pay.

- Medicare does not pay for all your health care costs. Medicare will only pay for covered services.
- When you receive an item or service that is not a Medicare benefit, you are responsible for payment, personally or through any other insurance you may have.

The purpose of this notice is to help you make an informed decision about whether you want to receive these services, knowing that you will have to pay for them yourself.

- MEDICARE MAY NOT PAY FOR: PHYSICAL THERAPY SERVICES OVER \$3000/YEAR
- MEDICARE WILL NOT PAY FOR OUTPATIENT PHYSICAL THERAPY SERVICES IF YOU RECEIVE ANY HOME HEALTH SERVICE
- MEDICARE WILL AUTOMATICALLY PERFORM A TARGETED REVIEW ON OUTPATIENT SERVICES EXCEEDING \$3000 TO DETERMINE IF SERVICES ARE MEDICALLY NECESSARY
- IF MEDICARE REQUESTS A RECOUPMENT, YOU WILL BE PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ENTIRE (NON-DISCOUNTED) AMOUNT

\*\*The review process may occur up to 2 years after you receive the services\*\*

Examples of home health services: nursing assistance, overnight care, and/or home physical therapy.

This is only a general summary of exclusions from Medicare benefits. It is not a legal document. The official Medicare program provisions are contained in relevant laws, regulations, and rulings.
